Patron Donor Sustaining Sustaining SSI	Any Company, Institution, Government Department, Corporation, Industry or Trade Association, connected with the Metallurgical, Metals related Industries, Education or Research will be eligible to be elected as Patron, Donor or Sustaining members in the category of corporate membership. An eminent individual connected with Metallurgical, Metals and Metals related Industries, Education and Research is also eligible to be elected as a Patron Member.
